


Since the accession to the throne of Grand Duke Adolf in 1890, Luxembourg has had its own dynasty, the Nassau-Weilbourg

- Louis XIV has to return the Duchy of Luxembourg to Spain (1697)
- The Duchy of Luxembourg passes under Austrian rule (1715)
